

FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT
CYCLE B
PRAYER OF THE FAITHFUL

Celebrant: Lord of all creation, hear the prayers we unite with the sacrifice which your Son gave us, as his new and eternal covenant. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
