


SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

A reading from the book of Deuteronomy
4:32-34. 39-40

*The Lord is God indeed, in heaven above as on earth

majestic, from one end of heaven to the other? Was
anything ever heard? Did ever a people hear the voice

by ordeals, signs, wonders, war with mighty hand and
outstretched arm, by fearsome terrors - all this that the
Lord your God did for you before your eyes in Egypt?

fear into your lives again; it is the spirit of sons, and it
makes us cry out, 'Abba, Father!' The Spirit himself

heirs of God and coheirs with Christ, sharing his
sufferings so as to share his glory.
