1. Holy Week Schedule of Masses are available on our parish website.
2. There will be no 9:00 am Mass on Tuesday, April 15, due to Chrism Mass at 10.30 am. All are invited to attend this Mass at which the Holy Oils are solemnly blessed by Bishop Paolo Martinelli.
3. On Holy Thursday the evening Masses of the Lord's Supper will be celebrated at 5:00 pm and 7:00 pm Outdoor.
4. Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence. Services in English will be at 2:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.
5. On Holy Saturday, there is no morning Mass. Solemn Morning Prayer will be conducted at 6:10 a.m. The Easter Vigil Masses will be at 7.00 pm and 10.00 pm.
6. You are encouraged to get your Lenten Sacrifice Envelope at the church entrances and return it on or before Easter Sunday.
7. Let us keep our Bishop Emeritus Paul Hinder in our prayers as he celebrates his 83<sup>rd</sup> birthday on 22nd April. On that day, we will have the Thanksgiving Mass at 7:00 pm.
